This democratic process is fundamental to fulfil our vision to **improve education for all our pupils**.

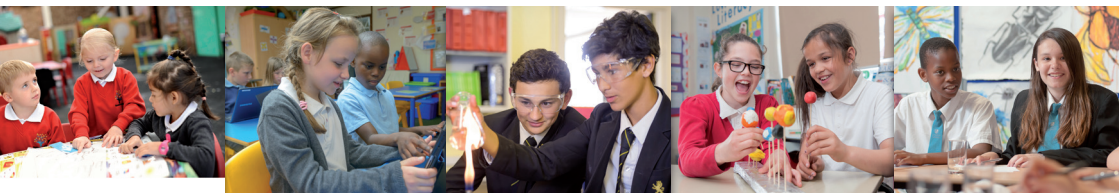
The Fellowship's Executives are questioned and challenged – and you can congratulate them too!
